No judicial office but I was elected to Terrell City Council in 1980 and as mayor pro tem in 1982.

14. What qualifications/assets do you feel you have which sets you apart from your opponent(s) and why should you be considered for endorsement by this organization?

I am the only Court of Criminal Appeals, Place 3, Democratic candidate that is Board Certified in Criminal Appellate Law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization. I have actively successfully practiced criminal law for over 30 years in both trial courts and appellate courts. I have extensive experience in direct appeals and in post-conviction work such as applications for writs of habeas corpus. I have argued cases before the U.S. 5th Cir., the Court of Criminal Appeals and the Courts of Appeal. I have also filed applications for certiorari and briefing to the U.S. Supreme Court.

I should be considered for endorsement because I am qualified but also because I am dedicated to the rule of law. The rule of law requires the law to apply to everyone; the laws are not secret or arbitrary; the laws are enforced fairly; and the justice system is fair. Unless these principals are applied to all, respect for the legal system as a whole is harmed. Exonerations we have experienced in criminal law show that the criminal justice system has flaws that must be recognized. Judges should recognize these flaws and be open to hearing all he facts including newly discovered information following convictions. Study and partnership among all three branches of government is needed to work on the unfairly disproportionate incarceration if minorities in our prison system and in pretrial detention jails. Mass incarceration itself is also an issue the Court of Criminal Appeals should address.

15. List at least three organizations that you belong to that reflect your personal and professional values (Include positions or offices held with each).

As a judicial candidate, I have avoided joining or renewing membership in organizations to be independent in judgment. I am a past member of the Texas Criminal Defense Lawyers Association and the Dallas Criminal Defense Lawyers Association, both of which advocate for fair and equal treatment for defendants, but support training and continuing legal education to promote competent legal representation, especially for indigent defendants. This I too believe. I served on the Terrell City Counsel, Terrell Board of Adjustments, and on the Terrell Library Board as chairman. In those positions I have sought to improve the quality of life for all constituents. I have volunteered as a mentor and volunteer moot court judge at the UNT Law School in Dallas where I can be involved in improving the legal community from the start. I encourage participation of law students in criminal law projects and to consider criminal law as a career.

16. Are there any past or pending criminal charges or convictions against you that are relevant to or would have an effect on the position you are seeking?

18. What are five major issues that you believe are faced by the Latino community and what would you do to bring about positive changes?

I began my career as an assistant District Attorney in Kaufman County in 1987. I opened a private law practice in about 1990 where I handled a variety of legal matters, such as probate, contract, family and criminal matters, for the local community in my hometown of Terrell. I have become more specialized in criminal appeals and became Board Certified in criminal appeals in 2014. In recent years, I have office locations in Dallas and Terrell and I have been practicing criminal and appellate law almost exclusively. I have also been appointed by the federal district courts to represent indigent defendant accused of federal crimes. In addition to Texas state courts, I am admitted to the Eastern and Northern U.S. District Courts and to the U.S. Supreme Court.

Texans deserve a qualified judge but should also demand a judge that applies the law fairly, has an open mind and willingness to hear to arguments and especially be

open to the discovery of new evidence during the review process. I believe I bring both the qualification and notions of fairness need on the Court of Criminal Appeals.
